Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 24 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

from which the original bearing trees:

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $45^{\circ}$  W., 8 lks. dist., down and rotted, mkd. with an open blaze and fragmentary scribe mks.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 8 lks. dist., down and rotted, no mks. remaining.

and bearing trees mkd. by Godfrey in 1963:

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N.  $23\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E., 15 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S24 CS BT.

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $17^{\circ}$  W., 41 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S25 BT.

- 0.85 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.  $35^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
- 2.00 Spur, slopes N.  $15^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 25 ft. over E. slope.
- 3.00 Slope changes; desc. 15 ft. along N. slope.
- 6.60 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.  $5^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 185 ft. over NW. slope.
- 23.65 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 85 ft. over NW. slope.
- 28.30 Spur, slopes N.  $30^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 30 ft. along N. slope.
- 31.45 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.  $25^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 90 ft. over general NW. slope.
- 36.30 Spur, slopes N.  $20^{\circ}$  W.; desc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.
- 38.90 Draw, drains N.  $25^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
- 40.01 The closing corner of secs. 24 and 25, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., protruding 10 ins. above ground, set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official record.
