

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of S. Bdy., T. 23 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

A down and rotting fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $45\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 20 lks. dist., no marks remain. (Record, S.  $50^{\circ}$  W.)

A down fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.  $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 38 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R7W S32 on bark blaze. (Record, N.  $45^{\circ}$  W.)

and a bearing tree mkd. by Byron

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R7W S33 CS BT on double blaze.

and new bearing tree

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $52\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R7W S32 BT.

N.  $89^{\circ} 22'$  W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 32, marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 20 ft. over SW. slope, through moderate timber and moderate undergrowth.

- 3.21 True point for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., hereinafter described; desc. 145 ft. over SW. slope.
- 11.70 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.40 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
- 20.00 McGee Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 145 ft. over SE. slope.
- 25.20 Fence bears N. and S., enter open prairie, edge bears N. and W.
- 26.00 McGee Creek Road, 20 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.
- 32.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 75 ft. over SW. slope.
- 34.80 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N.  $15^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $15^{\circ}$  E.
- 37.30 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
- 38.10 Point of spur, slopes S.; desc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.
- 40.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 20 ft. over E. slope.
- 40.99 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, perpetuated and recorded by R. C. Grant, in 1952, monumented with an iron pipe,  $\frac{3}{4}$  in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above the ground, from which the remains of the only remaining bearing tree:
- A charred and rotted fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S.  $50^{\circ}$  W., 81 lks. dist., 79 lks. dist., to face, with no marks remaining. (Record, 79 lks.)
- and bearing tree by Grant
- An oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N.  $8^{\circ}$  W., 206 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.
