5.55	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 35° W.; asc. 16 ft. over SE. slope.
6.91	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 56 ft. over W. slope.
14.65	Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. 430 ft. over E. slope.
24.10	Spur, slopes S. 20° E.; asc. 133 ft. over SE. slope.
33.08	Ridge, bears N. 25° W. and S. 25° E.; desc. 235 ft. over SW. slope.
47.87	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. From this point, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32, erroneously reestablished by Eggen, in 1957, bears West, 0.08 chs. dist., set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record. I remove the iron post, and at the above corner point Reset the iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked <div style="text-align: center;"> T 23 S R 6 W $\frac{1}{4}$ S 29 $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 1957 </div> from which A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 83° E., 87 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S32 BT. A madrone snag, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 65 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S29 BT. and the remaining bearing tree marked by Eggen, in 1957 A down fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 88° E., 76 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. There are no suitable live trees available within limits to the North of line. Descend 327 ft. over W. slope.
56.80	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 10° E.; asc. 424 ft. over E. slope.
65.97	Ridge, bears N. 50° W. and S. 50° E.; desc. 54 ft. over SW. slope.
73.92	Gully, drains SE.; asc. 132 ft. over E. slope.
77.20	Road, unimproved, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 337 ft. over SW. slope.
95.74	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32. Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam, rock outcroppings. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar; undergrowth, salal, poison oak, and vine maple. S. 89° 18' W., bet. secs. 30 and 31.
