Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 28° W., 60 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.

Ascend 160 ft. over broken S. slope.

46.60 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 160 ft. over NE. slope.

55.40 Ravine, drains S. 65° E.; asc. 180 ft. over S. slope.

59.975 Point for the N $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26.

A cedar, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 37° W., 60 lks. dist., mkd. N $\frac{1}{16}$ S26 BT.

Ascend 20 ft. over S. slope.

61.70 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 170 ft. over N. slope.

79.89 The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, remonumented by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1960, with iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears N. 5° E., 76 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, 72 lks.)

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 25° E., 37 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on opened blaze. (Whipple's 1894 record, 27 lks.)

A down and rotted fir, size indeterminate, bears S. 25° W., 22 lks. dist., with no marks remaining. (Whipple's 1894 record, S. 24° W., 38 lks.)
