

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of S. Bdy., T. 28 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A rotted fir stump, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 42° E., 12 lks. dist., with scribe marks T28S visible on portion of blaze lying at base of stump.

A down fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 55° W., 7 lks. dist., with opened and burned blaze.

and bearing trees marked by Byron

A dead fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. $35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 83 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 56° E., $23\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A madrone, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 44 lks. dist., with scribe marks T29S R8W S6 CS BT visible on partially healed double blaze.

A chinquapin, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 51° W., 57 lks. dist., with scribe marks S31 CS BT visible on partially healed double blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 35° E., 56 lks. dist., mkd. T28S R8W S32 BT.

Add marks BLM 1964 to bottom of brass cap.

S. $89^{\circ} 40'$ W., bet. secs. 6 and 31, along the S. bdy. of the Tp., marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 180 ft. over broken NW. slope, across logged area through heavy young timber and dense undergrowth.

17.05 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N. 70° W.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.

23.20 Middle Fork of Coquille River, 7 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. 35 ft. over SE. slope.

32.00 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 10 ft. over general W. slope.

35.43 Lake Creek, 7 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 15 ft. over gradual E. slope.

38.35 Upper Camas Road, asphaltic, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; leave timber, continue generally along E. and W. fence line, on S. side of a gravelled road.

40.18 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
