CHAINS

- 22.70 Wet draw, drains NW.; asc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.
- 24.60 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 135 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW.
- 29.70 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 220 ft. over SE. slope.
- 38.92 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original NE. bearing tree,
- A cedar snag, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 25 lks. dist., mkd. S and other illegible scribe mks. on open blaze.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 17¾° E., 60 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R7W S34 BT.
- A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 59¾° E., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R7W S3 BT.
- A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 59° W., 82 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R7W S4 BT.
- A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 77½° W., 109 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R7W S33 BT.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, pine, cedar, hemlock, madrone, maple, yew, alder, dogwood, chinquapin and live oak; undergrowth, salal, manzanita, young timber, arrowwood, Oregon grape, huckleberry, poison oak, ferns, and vines.
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- S. 89° 31' W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.
- Ascend 70 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy old-growth timber and thin undergrowth.
- 3.75 Draw, drains S. 80° E.; asc. 310 ft. over NE. slope, changing to E. slope.
- 17.60 Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 325 ft. over NW. slope, changing to SW. slope.
- 28.40 Wet draw, drains N. 75° W.; desc. 95 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
- 32.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 190 ft. over E. slope, changing to NE. slope.
