Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 36° E., 18 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R7W S4 BT on a bark blaze.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 12° W., 60 lks. dist., mkd. T32S R7W S5 BT on a bark blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
