## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The portion of township 31 south, range 7 west, covered by this resurvey lies about 12 miles southwest of Riddle, Oregon, in mountainous country. The elevation above mean sea level ranges from about 1,250 feet, where Middle Creek crosses the line between sections 32 and 33, to about 2,750 feet, on the ridge between Middle Creek and Cow Creek in the northern part of section 29. The soil is rocky clay with some rock outcrops noted along the lines resurveyed. The land is suited mainly for growth of timber.

Most of the country resurveyed is drained by Middle Creek, which flows in a southwesterly direction to Cow Creek several miles to the west, or by tributaries of Middle Creek. The northwestern portion of section 29 drains northwesterly into Cow Creek.

The timber is predominately Douglas fir, with lesser stands of pine, cedar, hemlock, madrone, maple, chinquapin, live oak, alder, yew, and dogwood. The undergrowth consists of young timber, salal, live oak, manzanita, huckleberry, poison oak, vine maple, Oregon grape, arrowwood, hazel, rhododendron, white-thorn, ferns, and vines.
