- 23.15 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.
- 23.50 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 30 ft. over W. slope.
- 28.20 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.
- 31.75 Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; enter open pasture land; edge bears N. and S.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.98 Point for the stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 43.18 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
- 43.65 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course N.; desc. 15 ft. along N. slope.
- 58.10 Paved road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.
- 60.10 Power line, 4 wires, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
- 67.90 Leave pasture land; enter oak timber; edge bears N. 65° E. and S. 45° W.
- 75.45 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N. 65° E.; asc. 20 ft. along general N. slope.
- 75.65 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 75.90 Enter open pasture land; edge bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 76.85 Power line, 4 wires, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.
