

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the S. Bdy. of T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A decayed fir stump, size indeterminate, bears N.  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 52 lks. dist., with no marks remaining. (Record bearing, N.  $40^{\circ}$  E.)

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.  $22\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 41 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record bearing, S.  $20^{\circ}$  W.)

A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 60 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record bearing, N.  $44^{\circ}$  W.)

and a tree marked by the County Surveyor,

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 41 lks. dist., with scribe marks T23S R8W CC S5 CS BT visible on unhealed blaze.

Add the marks BLM 1963 to the brass cap.

From this point, an iron post,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, bears East, 0.05 chs. dist., with brass cap marked

Ascend 7 ft. over SE. slope.

39.26 The cor. of secs. 31 and 32, monumented with an iron post not of record,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 10 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap marked

$$\begin{array}{c} S31\ S32 \\ \hline S6 \end{array}$$

from which the original bearing trees mkd. by Byars in 1881:

A stump hole, bears N.  $8^{\circ}$  E., 35 lks. dist.

A fir, 68 ins. diam., bears N.  $70^{\circ}$  W., 21 lks. dist., with scribe marks 2S R8W visible on bark blaze.

and a bearing tree marked by the County Surveyor in 1963,

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $38^{\circ}$  E., 48 lks. dist., with scribe marks S32 CS BT visible on unhealed blaze.

Add the marks BLM 1963 to brass cap.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salal, ceanothus, salmonberry, huckleberry, poison oak, Oregon grape, and fern.
