

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the E. Bdy. of T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Descend 220 ft. over general NW. slope, through scattering timber and medium undergrowth.

1.20 Paved road, 25 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

2.30 Power lines, bear N. 62½° W. and S. 62½° E.

30.50 Right bank of the Umpqua River, course E. Thence in river.

30.87 Point for meander cor. on right bank of the Umpqua River, at proportionate distance, falls in river; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

36.50 Left bank of the Umpqua River; asc. 110 ft. over general SE. slope.

37.31 Point for meander cor. on left bank of river, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.

40.48 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.

63.95 Gravelled road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.

80.96 Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A white oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 44° E., 590 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R7W S31 BT.

A white oak, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 66½° W., 169 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S36 BT.

A white oak, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 68½° W., 76 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S25 BT.

No suitable bearing tree available in section 30.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, oak, fir, maple, alder, and willow; undergrowth, vine maple, blackberry, arrowwood, fern, and poison oak.

N. 0° 21' W., bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Ascend 20 ft. over SE. slope, across pasture land, through scattering oak timber and light undergrowth.

10.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 450 ft. over general SE. slope.

38.80 Spur, slopes S. 25° W.; asc. 15 ft. over S. slope.
