	<p>A sawed fir stump, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 41 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.</p> <p>bearing trees marked by Price:</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 65 ins. diam., bears S. 7½° E., 487 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on burned face of blaze.</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 56¾° W., 220 lks. dist., with scribe marks R8W S visible on burned face of blaze.</p> <p>and a new bearing tree,</p> <p>A sawed fir stump, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 44½° W., 91 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S6 BT.</p> <p>Set a 7 ft. steel fence post, 2 ft. in the ground, along side the iron post.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy, rocky, clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, and alder; undergrowth, hazel, vine maple, salmonberry, salal, poison oak, Oregon grape, ceanothus, and fern.</p>

40.185	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
41.30	Right bank of the Umpqua River, course E.; thence in river.
41.39	Point for meander cor. on right bank of river, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
47.60	Left bank of the Umpqua River; asc. 350 ft. over general S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
47.72	Point for meander cor. on left bank of river, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
48.67	Gravelled road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.
57.15	Spur ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 70 ft. over NE. slope.
61.80	Branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 40° E.; asc. 265 ft. over SW. slope.
76.80	Enter pasture; edge bears NE. and SW.
