Dependent Resurvey, Portion Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

from which

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 82° E., 20 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S26 BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 16° W., 49 lks.
dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT.

Ascend 450 ft. over SE. slope; through scattered second-
growth timber and dense undergrowth.

59.90 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 380 ft. over NE. slope.

73.45 Dry ravine, drains N. 30° E.; asc. 90 ft. over SE. slope.

79.70 Spur, slopes N. 65° E.; desc. 60 ft. over N. slope.

81.64 Point for the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27, at pro-
portionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of
the original corner. (The departure of the east half
mile between secs. 22 and 27 is based on the random line
reported by Byars.)

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 78° E., 26 lks. dist.,
mkd. T22S R8W S26 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., $12\frac{1}{2}$ lks.
dist., mkd. T22S R8W S27 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 48° W., 21 lks.
dist., mkd. T22S R8W S22 BT.

From this point, the meander cor. of secs. 22 and 23, on
the left bank of the Umpqua River, bears N. 1° 55' W.,
77.16 chs. dist., determined at record bearing and dis-
tance from the remaining original bearing tree,

A white oak, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 62° W., 235
lks. dist., with axe marks, but no scribe marks
visible on opened and decayed blaze.

and bearing trees marked by the County Surveyor in 1945:

A white oak, 38 ins. diam., bears S. $18\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 158
lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A black oak, 42 ins. diam., bears S. $65\frac{3}{4}$ ° W.,
254 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.
