Dependent Resurvey, Portion Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

A maple, 8 ins. diam., bears N. $18\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 81 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S5 BT.

A maple, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 5° E., 44 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S8 BT.

A maple, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 72° W., 100 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S7 BT.

A rock outcrop, 6 ft. high, bears N. 32° W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. X B O on lower portion.

From this point, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, bears S. $87^\circ 55'$ W., 38.76 chs. dist., monumented with the original corner tree, a down fir, 15 ins. diam., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S visible on bark blaze, from which the original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 7° E., 20 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on bark blaze. (Record bearing and distance, North, 16 lks.)

A fir snag, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 38 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on bark blaze. (Record bearing and distance, S. 25° E., 36 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

$$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \frac{S\ 6}{S\ 7} \\ T\ 22\ S\ R\ 8\ W \\ 1963 \end{array}$$

from which a new bearing tree,

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. $19\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 85 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.

Set a 7 ft. steel fence post, 24 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy and rocky.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, alder, madrone, and cascara; undergrowth, salal, fern, poison oak, hazel, and bunch grass.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.
