

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 15.60 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
- 16.90 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.
- 21.85 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
- 23.65 Ravine, drains NW.; asc. 130 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 35.70 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.46 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

A burned fir snag, 52 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 34 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 BT.

No other suitable bearing tree available.

Set a 7 ft. steel fence post, 24 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

Descend 40 ft. over NW. slope.

- 42.30 Ravine, drains W.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
- 43.35 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
- 45.95 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.
- 59.19 Point for the N $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

A fir snag, 22 ins. diam., bears S. $86\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 70 lks. dist., mkd. N $\frac{1}{16}$ S5 BT.

A sawed fir stump, 55 ins. diam., bears N. 72° W., 47 lks. dist., mkd. N $\frac{1}{16}$ S6 BT.

Deposit a truck wheel hub and set a 7 ft. steel fence post, 24 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post as a memorial.

Ascend 100 ft. over broken SW. slope.

- 60.25 Dirt road, 25 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
- 64.55 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 320 ft. over NE. slope.
- 72.15 Ravine, drains NW.; asc. 15 ft. over SW. slope.
