

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Resurvey of Boundaries, Claim No. 49, T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

from which

An oak, 9 ins. diam., bears N.  $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S27 CC BT.

An oak, 20 ins. diam., bears N.  $20\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 303 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S28 CC BT.

From this point the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, bears S.  $0^{\circ} 59'$  E., 19.91 chs. dist., determined from the bearing trees described in the official record of the 1962 resurvey. The iron post is buried in a road.

42.13 Point for closing cor. at intersection with the N. and S. center line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 27, hereinafter described.

61.59 Point for closing cor. at intersection with the N. and S. center line of sec. 27, hereinafter described.

90.39 Point for the NE. cor. of Claim No. 54, determined by the method of broken boundaries, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $40^{\circ}$  E., 91 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S27 BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S.  $71^{\circ}$  W., 59 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W C54 BT.

S.  $0^{\circ} 15'$  E., on a blank line along the E. bdy. of Claim No. 54.

20.05 Point for closing cor. at intersection with the line bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A white fir, 37 ins. diam., bears N.  $46^{\circ}$  E., 92 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S27 CC BT.

A white fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S.  $28^{\circ}$  E., 30 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S34 CC BT.

From this point the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, bears S.  $89^{\circ} 40'$  E., 11.77 chs. dist., heretofore described.
