Remonumentation Certain Original Corner Points,
T. 22 S., R. 8 W., Will. Mer., Oregon

CHAINS

The following field notes describe the remonumentation of certain original corner points in township 22 south, range 8 west, of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, as provided for in the General Special Instructions, Group Number 350, Oregon, dated May 3, 1957, "Investigation of Collateral or Physical Evidence of Corner Positions and Accessories, Followed by Remonumentation of Corner Points, With New Accessories When Needed". For reasons of clarity, the history of each corner is given where the remonumentation is described.

North Boundary, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian,
Oregon

(Rehabilitation of a corner established by Norman D.
Price in 1945)

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, on the S. bdy. of T. 21 S., R. 8 W. The iron post set by Price is found leaning and partially covered by a fallen tree; the true position is determined from the original bearing trees:

A fir stub, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 30° E., 227 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S visible on partly healed blaze.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears N. $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 38 lks. dist., with a burned-out blaze.

At the corner point

Reset the iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which a new bearing tree,

A fir, 56 ins. diam., bears N. $69\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 203 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.

West Boundary, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian,
Oregon

(Remonumenting a corner established by George F. Rigby
in 1931)

The angle point bet. secs. 13 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground with brass cap marked

from which bearing trees mkd. by Rigby

A rotted fir stump, 46 ins. diam., bears N. $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 34 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

A maple, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 71° W., 21 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.
