	Ascend 610 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
17.00	Ridge, dividing Umpqua River and Little Wolf Creek drainages, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 125 ft. over N. slope.
19.99	Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.  Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 2½° E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S 6 BT.
	A fir, 47 ins. diam., bears N. 47° W., 94 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S 1 BT.
	Descend 340 ft. over N. slope.
23.00	Enter logged area, edge bears NW. and E.; continue through heavy young timber and dense undergrowth.
30.20	Ravine, drains N. 30° W.; desc. 130 ft. over broken NW slope.
39.15	Point for the witness cor. to the ¼ Sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.  Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A fir, 79 ins. diam., bears N. 61° E., 156 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.
	A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 47° W., 261 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.
	Descend 5 ft. over creek bank.
39.98	True point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. The cor. point falls in Little Wolf Creek, 20 lks. wide, from S. 60° W., course, N., where it is impractical to establish a permanent monument.
	Continue down Little Wolf Creek.
44.00	Leave Little Wolf Creek, course N. 30° E.; continue across nearly level creek bottom.
49.65	Same creek, 20 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; asc. 70 ft. over broken SW. slope.
55.00	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
