 dist., mkd. T25S R8W S11 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.  $44\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 55 lks.  
 dist., mkd. T25S R8W S14 BT.

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears S.  $62\frac{3}{4}^\circ$  W., 24 lks.  
 dist., mkd. T25S R8W S15 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.  $81^\circ$  W., 31 lks.  
 dist., mkd. T25S R8W S10 BT.

Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, rocky clay.  
 Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, madrone, maple, chinquapin,  
 alder, dogwood and yew; undergrowth, salal, rhododendron,  
 arrowwood, Oregon grape, huckleberry, vine maple, poison  
 oak, vines and ferns.

S.  $82^\circ 29'$  W., bet. secs. 11 and 14.

Ascend 160 ft. over N.E. slope, through heavy timber and  
 dense undergrowth.

5.20 Spur, slopes S.  $50^\circ$  E.; asc. 15 ft. over S.E. slope.

10.35 Dirt road, 25 lks. wide, bears N.  $30^\circ$  E. and S.  $30^\circ$  W.

12.90 Ridge, bears N.  $20^\circ$  E. and S.  $20^\circ$  W.; desc. 620 ft. over  
 S.W. slope.

38.85 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.  $60^\circ$  W.; asc. 5 ft. over N.E. slope.

39.46 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 11 and 14, at proportionate  
 distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original  
 corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
 in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

46.75 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 30 ft. over N.W. slope.

48.20 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 150 ft. over E. slope.
