

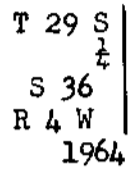
County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS
54.30

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 4 W., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $57\frac{1}{4}^\circ$ W., 16 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT.

A cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears N. $22\frac{1}{4}^\circ$ W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. X at breast height and BT at the base.

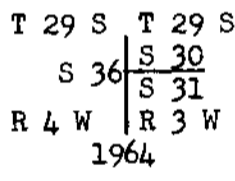
Descend 120 ft. over N.W. slope.

60.35 Ravine, drains N. 75° W.; asc. 175 ft. over S.W. slope, changing to S. slope.

74.45 Spur, slopes S. 75° W.; desc. 65 ft. over N.W. slope.

80.72 Point for the cor. of secs. 30 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N. $46\frac{3}{4}^\circ$ E., 65 lks. dist., mkd. T29S R3W S30 BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 38° E., 92 lks. dist., mkd. T29S R3W S31 BT.

The corner is located at the edge of logged area, edge bears E. and W.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, maple, madrone. oak, alder, dogwood and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, Oregon grape, poison oak, hazel, arrowwod, ferns and vines.

N. $1^\circ 35'$ E., on the W. bdy. of sec. 30.

Descend 220 ft. over N.W. slope, through logged area.

12.28 The cor. of secs. 25 and 36 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 4 W., perpetuated and recorded by Arthur R. Evans, Deputy County Surveyor in 1949, from the remains of the original bearing trees which are no longer in existence. In 1962 James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, remonumented the corner from the remains of the Evan's BT, with an iron post, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.
