Dependent Resurvey of the W. Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T29S R4W S25 BT.

Add the marks BLM to the brass cap.

N. $0^{\circ} 41'$ E., beginning new measurement.

Descend 135 ft. over N. slope, changing to N.E. slope.

6.90 South Myrtle Creek, 25 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 245 ft. over S. slope, changing to S.E. slope.

7.80 Paved road, 32 lks. wide, bears E. and W.

8.15 Woven wire fence, bears E. and W., enter field.

14.00 Woven wire fence, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W., enter pasture.

26.50 Enter logged area, edge bears N. 10° E. and S. 80° W.

31.84 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 19 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

No permanent monument established.

Ascend 75 ft. over S.E. slope, changing to S.W. slope.

38.82 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 24 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 4 W., remonumented and recorded by M. B. Germond, County Surveyor, in 1918. Subsequently remonumented by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1960, with an iron post, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.

A burned pine stump, 46 ins. diam., bears S. 20° W., 210 lks. dist., with recent axe marks visible.

and bearing trees mkd. by Germond

A sawed fir stump, 24 ins. diam., bears N. $28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 21 lks. dist., mkd. CS on an open blaze.

A stump hole, bears S. $15\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 77 lks. dist.

and bearing trees marked by Byron

A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N. $71\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S24 CS BT on double blaze.

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears N. $26\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., $43\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S24 CS BT.

and a bearing tree not of record.

A sawed fir stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. $52\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 46 lks. dist., mkd. BT on bark blaze.

Add the marks BLM to the brass cap.
