CHAINS

A Douglas fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 57° E.,  
55½ lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S7 BT.

A Douglas fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W.,  
39 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S18 BT.

Ascend 250 ft. over E. slope, changing to NE. slope.

49.55 Ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 710 ft. over  
W. slope, changing to SW. slope.

72.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 10° W.; asc. 170 ft. over  
SE. slope.

80.00 Spur, slopes South; desc. 65 ft. over NW. slope.

83.08 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the W. bdy. of  
the Tp.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, ricky clay.

Timber, Douglas fir, scattering of ponderosa pine and incense  
cedar and madrone; undergrowth, chinquapin, oak, madrone,  
vine maple, ceanothus, manzanita, white thorn, and poison oak.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.

N. 0° 49' W., bet. secs. 7 and 8.

Descend 400 ft. over N. slope.

6.75 Road, unimproved; 20 lks. wide, bears N. 65° W. and  
S. 65° E.

13.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; asc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.

13.75 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 105 ft. over N. slope.

19.80 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 55° W.; asc. 10 ft. over  
SW. slope.

20.20 Spur, slopes N. 55° W.; desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope.

25.10 Section Creek, 6 lks. wide, course N. 30° E.; asc. 20 ft.  
over SE. slope.

27.30 Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 60 ft. over NE. slope,  
changing to N. slope.

32.40 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 70° E.; asc. 55 ft. over  
SE. slope.

35.85 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.

37.75 Swale, drains E.; asc. 5 ft. over SE. slope.

38.14 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 8, at proportionate  
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original  
corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
