	<p style="text-align: center;">Remonumentation of Certain Original Corner Points, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon</p> <hr/> <p>The following field notes describe the remonumentation of certain original corner points of Township 33 South, Range 6 West, of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, as provided for in the General Special Instructions, Group Number 350, Oregon, dated May 3, 1957, "Investigation of Collateral or Physical Evidence of Corner Positions and Accessories, followed by remonumentation of Corner Points, With New Accessories When Needed."</p> <p>The history of original corner establishments is referred to at appropriate places in the field notes of the remonumentations.</p> <p>The remonumentation of original corner points was made at the request of the Medford District Manager for administrative purposes of the Bureau of Land Management.</p>
