A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $48\frac{3}{4}^\circ$  E.,  $58\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. T29S R8W S31 CC BT.

From this point the NE. cor. of the William P. Day Donation Land Claim No. 44, bears N.  $0^\circ 01'$  W., 71.57 chs. dist., determined at the intersection of fences extending S., E., and W. This point is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner, and is used by local land owners.
