31.50 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; desc. 80 ft. over W. slope.

35.16 The closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 32 S., R. 5 W., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 14 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 21° E., 60 lks. dist. with scribe marks T32S R5 visible on an opened blaze.

A ponderosa pine, 46 ins. diam., bears N. 81° W., 58 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and bearing trees mkd. by the County Surveyor

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 17° E., 12 lks. dist. mkd. CC T32S R5W S36 CS BT.

A madrone, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 31° W., 12 lks. dist., mkd. CC T32S R5W S35 CS BT.

Descend 120 ft. over W. slope.

40.50 The Ives and Hyde standard cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, rehabilitated by Sharp in 1894, determined at record distance from the remains of the original bearing trees. This corner now becomes an angle point of sections 1 and 35.

A burned and rotted pine stump, size indeterminate bears N. 55° E., 71 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Record bearing, N. 51° E.)

A burned and rotted pine stump, size indeterminate bears S. 43° E., 102 lks. dist., mkd. BT on a pitch sliver. This tree remarked by Sharp in 1894. (Record bearing S. 47½° E.)

A burned and rotted pine stump, size indeterminate, bears S. 47° W., 105 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A sawed ponderosa pine stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 61° W., 125 lks. dist., mkd. S35 BT on opened blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Sharp

A ponderosa pine, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 77° E., 36 lks. dist. mkd. S36 BT on a partially healed blaze. (Record bearing, N. 70° E.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
