A Douglas fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 49° E.,
65 lks. dist., mkd. AP T32S R5W S35 BT.

An incense cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 51° E.,
52 lks. dist., mkd. AP T33S R5W S1 BT.

The angle point is located on the east edge of an
unimproved road, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.

N. 89° 40' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 25 ft. over SW. slope.

0.05 Road, unimproved, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 15° W. and
S. 15° E.

1.25 Dry bed of creek, 5 lks. wide, drains S. 30° W.;
thence along S. slope.

4.12 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with an
iron pipe, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, flush with the
ground surface, from which the remaining original
bearing trees mkd. by Sharp.

A Douglas fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E.,
54 lks. dist., mkd. T33S R5W CC on opened
blaze.

A sawed white fir stump, 16 ins. diam., bears
S. 34° E., 41 lks. dist., no marks visible.
(Record bearing, S. 44° E.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins.
in the ground, directly over the iron pipe, with
brass cap mkd.
