CHAINS

The soil is a rocky clay and covered with a heavy stand of timber. The timber is predominately fir with a scattering of madrone, dogwood, chinquapin, yew, maple, and cedar. Undergrowth consists chiefly of fern, salal, Oregon grape, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, and timber reproduction.

No evidence of mineral deposits were noted in the area.

The average of several readings along the line resurveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of $18^{\circ} 15'$ E. There is a range of up to 1° in local attraction.
