Entry, I make the following retracements: Commencing at cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, T. 32 S., R. 3 W., Willamette Meridian, which is a *sermentine stone, 8x6x6 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, I run S.89°51'W. (recorded bearing) retracing line bet. secs. 21 and 28.

39.83

Fall 10 lks. S.0°09'E. of the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 21 and 28, which is a granite stone 8x8x6 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

(The true bearing and length of this line is west, 39.83 chs.)

From cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, heretofore described, I run S.0°02'E. (recorded bearing) retracing line bet. secs. 27 and 28.

39.96

Fall 3 lks. N.89°58'E. of the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 27 and 28, which is a basalt stone 12x10x7 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

(The true bearing and length of this line is S.0°01'W., 39.96 chs.)

TRACT A

All listing cors. referred to herein are properly identified, being mkd. and witnessed as described by the Forest Service in the listing survey.

September 10, 1916: I begin at cor. No. 1 of this survey, identical with cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, heretofore described. I mark the stone with a cross for chaining point, and alongside of cor.

Set a granite stone 24x8x6 ins. 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross, mkd. 1 HES 186 on side facing the claim.

Thence I run S.0°01'W. on a true line, bet. secs. 27 and 28, along east bdy. of unlisted tract.

Gradual ascent of NE. slope, through fir timber and undergrowth.

2.24

Trail bears NW. and SE.

2.90

Top of spur, 45 ft. above cor. No. 1, slopes northwest; thence gradual descent of SW. slope.

7.97

Creek, 5 lks. wide, course northwest.

11.60

Cor. No. 2 (40 ft. below top of ascent).

Set a granite stone 26x12x8 ins., 16 in. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for closing cor. and cor. No. 2 of this survey, mkd. C C on west face and 2 HES 186 on side facing the claim:

A fir 10 ins. dia. bears S.58°33'E., 18 lks. dist., mkd. X2 HES 186 BT.

A fir 50 ins. dia. bears N.24°30'W., 42 lks. dist., mkd. X2 HES 186 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3-1/2 ft. dist. on line west of cor.

Thence I run: West on a true line, along south bdy. of unlisted
