HOMESTEAD ENTRY SURVEY NO. 186 SECS. 21 & 28 T 32 S R 3 W

CHAINS

40.56 Intersect line bet. secs. 21 and 28, east 29.05 chs. dist. from the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 21 and 28 and west 10.78 chs. dist. from cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, identical with cor. No. 1 of this survey.

At point of intersection: Set a granite stone 25x8x8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for closing cor. and cor. No. 9 of this survey, mkd. C C on SW. face and 9 HES 186 on side facing the claim:

- from which -

A fir 18 ins. dia. bears S.1°45'E., 144 lks. dist., mkd. X 9 HES 186 BT.

No other bearings available; pits impracticable.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3-1/2 ft. dist. on line SW. of cor.

Thence I run: East on a true line, bet. secs. 21 and 28.

Through scattering fir and fallen timber.

3.40 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course NW.

7.05 Trail bears NW. and SE.

9.50 Summit of slight rise; descend.

10.78 To cor. No. 1, the place of beginning.

TRACT B

I begin at cor. No. 10, on the sec. line bet. secs. 21 and 28, at a point west .49 chs. dist. from cor. No. 9, Tract A, and east 28.56 chs. dist. from the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 21 and 28, and on the west side of road exemption.

Set a granite stone 26x15x14 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for closing cor. and cor. No. 10 of this survey, mkd. C C on SW. face and 10 HES 186 on side facing the claim.

No bearings available; pits impracticable.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, on line 3-1/2 ft. dist. southwest of cor.

Thence I run: S.35°04'W. on a true line, along west side of road exemption (unlisted land) through fir timber and undergrowth.

5.20 West Fork Appelgate Creek, 15 lks. wide, course N.65°W.

5.27 Pass to List 6-422.

28.63 Pass to List 6-969.

40.19 Cor. No. 11.

Set a conglomerate stone 24x12x7 ins. 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 11 of this survey, mkd. 11 HES 186 on side facing the claim:
