

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

HOMESTEAD ENTRY SURVEY NO. 186 SECS. 21 & 28 T 32 S R 3 W

CHAINS

Cor. No. 4 of List 6-422, which I destroy, bears S.20°00'W., 9.95 chs. dist.

Thence, from cor. No. 13 of this survey, I run N.20°00'E. on a random line and 26.00 chs. intersect cor. No. 5 of listing survey.

(The true bearing and length of this line is N.20°00'E., 26.00 chs.)

Returning to cor. No. 13 of this survey, above described, I run: N.20°00'E. on a true line, passing to List 6-422.

Gradual ascent of SE. slope, through dense undergrowth and fir timber.

1.80 Top of ascent 50 ft. above cor. No. 13; thence along broken south-easterly slope.

3.30 Draw, course southeast.

8.80 Draw, course southeast.

14.83 Intersect line bet. secs. 21 and 28, east 20.44 chs. dist. from the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 21 and 28 and west 8.12 chs. dist. from cor. No. 10 of this survey.

At point of intersection: Set a granite stone 24x7x7 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for closing cor. and cor. No 14 of this survey, mkd. C C on SW. face and 14 HES 186 on side facing the claim:

- from which -

A fir 50 ins. dia. bears S.31°15'W., 43 lks. dist., mkd X 14 HES 186 BT.

An alder 8 ins. dia. bears N.78°00'E., 58 lks. dist., mkd. X 14 HES 186 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3-1/2 ft. dist. on line southwest of cor.

Left bank of West Fork Applegate Creek bears east 1.00 ch. dist., course north.

Thence I run: N.20°00'E. on a true line.

Through dense undergrowth and fir timber.

10.20 West Fork Applegate Creek, 20 lks. wide, course north.

11.17 Cor. No. 15, identical with cor. No. 5 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place: Set a granite stone 24x8x6 ins., 14 ins. in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 15 of this survey, mkd. 15 HES 186 on side facing the claim:

- from which -

A yew 8 ins. dia. bears S.42°00'W., 38 lks. dist., mkd. X 15 186 BT.

A granite outcropping showing 3x2x2 ft. above ground, bears N.81°12'W., 51 lks. dist., mkd. X 15 HES 186 B.R.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, 3-1/2 ft. dist. with in the claim.
