Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.

A dead fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.45°W., 22 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 1 E S 4 C C B T. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.36°W., 70 lks. dist., mkd. T 30 S R 1 E S 4 C C B T. (New B.T.)

Asc. 75 ft. over E. slope.

The cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, which is a cross (X) on bedrock, with 3 grooves on E. and W. side of cross.

At point for corner,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.23°E., 40 lks. dist., blaze healed; I do not open. (Old B.T.)

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.15¼°W, 20 lks. dist., blaze healed; I do not open. (Old B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, madrona, cedar, hemlock, and yew.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, huckleberry, serviceberry, salal, and spirea.

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Subdivision of Part of T. 30 S., R. 1 E.

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From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on S. bdy. of the Tp., previously described in the field notes of T. 31 S., R. 1 E. of this Group.

N.0° 02' W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Desc. 200 ft. over rolling W. slope, changing to NE. slope, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.
