

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

## CHAINS

from which

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 34° W., 146 lks.  
dist., mkd. T22S R8W S20 CC BT.

A hemlock, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 56° W., 17 lks.  
dist., mkd. T22S R8W S29 CC BT.

From this point the NW. cor. of Claim No. 45, bears  
N. 0° 30' W., 2.10 chs. dist., hereinafter described.

Descend 164 ft. over general SE. slope.

25.70 Graveled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. and S.

36.11 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, at mid-  
point in departure bet. the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29,  
and 30, and the cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28, and 29.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A white oak, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 15° E., 53 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S20 BT.

A white fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 19° W., 9 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S29 BT.

Descend 65 ft. over general SE. slope.

39.55 Henderer Road, graveled, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 47° W.  
and S. 47° E.

41.50 Point for the meander corner bet. secs. 20 and 29, at  
record bearing and distance, as based on the Byar  
survey; there is no remaining evidence of the original  
corner. No permanent monument established.

From this point the point for the witness point bet.  
secs. 20 and 29, as based on the Harvey Gordon and  
Charles T. Gardner survey, bears N. 59° 24' W., 4.10  
chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay loam.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin,  
madrone, maple, and oak; undergrowth, vinemaple,  
salmonberry, hazel, arrowwood, huckleberry, blackberry,  
salal, manzanita, poison oak, willow, Scotch broom,  
rhododendron, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29, and 30.

N. 86° 25' W., bet. secs. 19 and 30.

Descend 203 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and  
dense undergrowth.

3.35 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.
