

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

T. 33 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

The following field notes describe the remonumentation of certain original corner points in township 33 south, range 7 west, Willamette Meridian, Oregon, as provided for in the General Special Instructions, Group No. 350, Oregon, dated May 3, 1957, "Investigation of Collateral or Physical Evidence of Corner Positions and Accessories, Followed by Remonumentation of Corner Points, with New Accessories When Needed."

The remonumentations were made at the request of the Medford District Manager, for administrative purposes of the Bureau of Land Management.

West Boundary, T. 33 S., R. 7 W.,  
Willamette Meridian, Oregon

(Remonumenting corners established by Oscar F. Thiel, in 1901, and rehabilitated and changed to corners of minimum control by Norman D. Price and Ira F. Shaffner, in 1919)

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 7 only, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., determined at record distance from the original bearing trees:

A live oak stool, bears S. 61° E., 9 lks. dist.

A burned sugar pine stump, size indeterminate, bears N. 48° W., 72 lks. dist., marks destroyed by Price and Shaffner. (Record, N. 38° W.)

and a bearing tree marked by Price and Shaffner.

A sugar pine, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 45° E., 25 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT on partially healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 75° E., 127 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 44° E., 125 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.

The cor. of secs. 6 and 7 only, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., determined at record bearing and distance from the original bearing trees:

A fir, 46 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 48 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on bark blaze.

A fir, 28 ins., diam., bears S. 54° E., 37 lks. dist., mkd. T33S R7W S7 BT on bark blaze.

A down chinquapin, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 57° W. 84 lks. dist., marks destroyed by Price and Shaffner.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 76° W., 72 lks. dist., marks destroyed by Price and Shaffner.
