Dependent Resurvey, Portion of E. Bdy., T. 20 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 25 and 36 only, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. dia., protruding 12 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.

A stump hole, bears S. 17° W., 63 lks. dist., with burned and fallen fir lying alongside, 40 ins. diam., with no marks remaining.

A burned twin maple, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 77° W., 12 lks. dist., mkd. with a healed blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Tillman in 1950

A burned hemlock, 17 ins. diam., bears N. 12½° W., 67 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on burned and partially healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A burned fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 26½° W., 130 lks. dist., mkd. T20S R8W S36 BT.

Set a steel fence post alongside the iron post.

N. 1° 07' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 25, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 110 ft. over S.W. slope, through burned timber and undergrowth.

- 7.30 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc, 260 ft. over steep broken NE. slope.
- 15.85 Ravine, drains S. 80° E.; asc. 75 ft. over steep SE. slope.
- 17.71 Point for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, T. 20 S., R. 7 W., hereinafter described.
- Ascend 152 ft. over steep SE. slope.
- 20.95 Spur, slopes N. 80° E.; desc. 240 ft. over steep N. slope.
- 25.20 Ravine, drains N. 65° E.; asc. 150 ft. over SE. slope.
- 28.85 Top of ascent, slopes S. 70° E.; desc 20 ft. along steep E. slope.
- 30.05 Head of ravine, drains S. 75° E.; asc. 150 ft. over steep SE. slope.
- 33.25 Gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and SW.
- 33.90 Ridge, dividing Hardenbrook Creek and South Sister Creek drainages, bears N. 70° E. and SW.; desc 220 ft. over steep NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
- 39.73 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 25 only, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., protruding 14 ins. above the ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.
