S. $89^{\circ} 50'$ W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 32, marking the true line.

Descend 240 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.

11.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; asc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.

12.30 Point of spur, slopes NW.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

12.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 65 ft. over NE. slope.

19.00 Spur, slopes NW, desc. 210 ft. over NW. slope.

29.20 Creek, 8 lks wide, course S.; asc. 55 ft. over SE. slope.

35.85 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 80° E.; asc. 80 ft. over NE. slope.

40.12 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. cor.

Ascend 240 ft. over NE. slope, changing to SE. slope.

A fir snag, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 25° E., 48 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially opened blaze.

A fir, 75 ins. diam., bears S. 40° W., 18 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on weathered bark blaze.
