A fir, 65 ins. diam., bears N. 16° E., 9 lks. dist., mkd.  
T26S R8W S19 BT.

From this point United States Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station ELWOODS 1953, bears S. 67° 51' E., 18.61 chs. dist., monumented with a standard brass cap, 3½ ins. diam., firmly set in a concrete post, 10 ins. diam., extending 8 ins. above ground, with top marked ELWOODS 1953, and a triangle.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, maple, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, madrone, and myrtle; undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, huckleberry, salmonberry, arrowwood, hazel, manzanita, ceanothus, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape, and fern.

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion  
of the Subdivisional Lines,  
T. 26 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

(Restoring the 1896 survey by William P. Heydon)

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 1° 01' E., bet. secs. 32 and 33, marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 135 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 7.15 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.
- 18.00 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 120 ft. over NW. slope.
- 25.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 95 ft. over SW. slope.
- 37.30 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 25 ft. over N. slope.
- 38.80 Callahan Road, 25 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
- 40.36 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, perpetuated and recorded by Marvin C. Ramsey, Registered Land Surveyor, in 1960, with an iron pipe, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set 28 ins. in the ground, from which the original bearing trees:
- A fir, 58 ins. diam., bears N. 84° E., 33 lks. dist., with scribe mark 4 visible on opened blaze. (Record, East)
- A sawed fir stump, 50 ins. diam., bears S. 62° W., 46 lks. dist., with no marks visible on opened blaze. (Record, S. 85° W.)
- and a tree marked by Ramsey
- A hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 48° W., 26 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S32 RS404 BT visible on open blaze.
