CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins diam., 24 ins. in the ground with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 68° W., 15½ lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S31 BT.

Ascend 10 ft. over gradual SE. slope.

21.75 Callahan Road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E., and ridge, bears NW. and SE.; asc. 60 ft. over SE. slope.

33.30 Spur, slopes NE.; desc 190 ft. over NW. slope.

40.13 Point for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 43° W., 46 lks. dist., mkd. T26S R8W S30 BT.

Timber, fir, hemlock, yew, cedar, alder, and chinquapin; undergrowth rhododendron, huckleberry, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salmonberry manzanita, Oregon grape, salal, poison oak, and fern.

S. 89° 22' W., bet. secs. 29 and 32.

Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.30 Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 215 ft. over W. slope.

7.70 Ravine, drains N. 30° W.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.

11.50 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 270 ft. over NW. slope.

19.20 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 45 ft. over NE. slope.

21.80 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.
