57.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 550 ft. over general W. slope.

81.10 The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, maple, alder, dogwood, chinquapin,

Ascend 15 ft. over SW. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

10.00 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 365 ft. over NW. slope.

22.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 240 ft. over SW. slope.

30.90 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 95 ft. over NW. slope.

34.65 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 75° W.; asc. 120 ft. over SW. slope.

39.70 Point for the center  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor of sec. 30, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
