Claim N. 37, bears S. ~~89° 48'~~ E., 45.375 chs. dist., perpetuated
and recorded by J. W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1961, monu-
mented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., protruding 20 ins. above
ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.

with scribe mark T visible on partially opened blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Byron

A white oak, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 65° W., 124 lks. dist.,
with a healed blaze.

A white oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 11° W., 115 lks. dist.

Descend 10 ft. over gradual NE. slope.

51.00 Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NW., curving to N.; continue along
creek.

52.50 Leave creek, course N. 25° W.; asc. 5 ft. over gradual SW. slope.

58.00 Top of ascent, slopes NW., and a dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW.
and SE.; desc. 5 ft. over gradual N. slope.

61.005 Point for the center N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 5.

No permanent monument established.

Descend 5 ft. over gradual N. slope.

63.60 Dry bed of creek, 30 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 320 ft. over
SE. slope.

66.23 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 80° W.; enter parti-
ally logged area covered with scattering timber and light under-
growth.
