	N. 88° 04' W., on the E. and W. center line of sec. 5.
	Ascend 30 ft. along N. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.
6.70	Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
12.50	Bottom of descent, drains N.; asc. 15 ft. over NE. slope.
15.50	Spur, slopes NW.; and a dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 60 ft. over W. slope.

	Descend 210 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.
31.00	Enter open pasture land, edge bears N. 25° W. and S 25° E.
33.20	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.
35.50	Creek, 12 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; asc. 40 ft. over E. slope.
38.70	Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 15° E.; enter heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.
39.54	The center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5.
	Ascend 120 ft. over steep E. slope.
43.30	Spur, slopes N. 70° E., and a wire fence, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.; asc. 75 ft. over SE. slope.
48.80	Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.
50.30	Bottom of descent, drains S.; asc. 375 ft. over steep SE. slope.
66.50	Spur ridge, bears NE. and S. 20° W.; desc. 370 ft. over NW. slope.
77.40	Enter burned and logged area, edge bears NW. and SE.
79.40	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6.
	From the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8, monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., protruding 2 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the 1958 resurvey.
