Dependent Resurvey, Portion of E. bdy., T. 21 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

and new bearing trees

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 81° E., 100 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W S18 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 54° E., 109 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W S19 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, and alder; undergrowth, vine maple, arrowwood, hazel, ceanothus, salmonberry, blackberry, thimbleberry, huckleberry, rhododendron, salal, poison oak, Oregon grape and fern.

N. 0° 35' E., on the W. bdy. of sec. 18, T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

Descend 145 ft. over NE. slope, through logged area and dense undergrowth.

3.50 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.

6.70 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 35 ft. over NE. slope.

8.40 Bottom of descent, slopes E.; asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.

10.80 Spur, slopes N. 60° E.; desc. 525 ft. over broken N. slope.

25.80 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 60° E.; asc. 125 ft. over SE. slope.

29.60 Spur, slopes S. 75° E.; desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

32.80 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 70° E.; asc. 4 ft. across creek bottom.

34.40 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 35° E.; asc. 35 ft. over SW. slope.

36.00 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.; enter area of the Oxbow Burn.

36.29 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 13 only, T. 21 S., R. 9 W., established at midpoint latitudinally on the E. bdy. of sec. 13.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

38.10 The 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 18 only, T. 21 S., R. 8 W., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., extending 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap marked
