A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N. $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 47 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT.A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 80° E., 17 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT.N. $0^{\circ} 57'$ E., beginning new measurement.
