A cedar, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 5* W., 24 lks. dist., mkd. 1/2 S4 BT.

An alder, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 51* E., 12 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

No other suitable tree available in section 4.

The corner is located on the right bank of Vincent Creek, 80 lks. wide, course N., turning to NW.

Ascend 345 ft. over SW. slope.

33.70 Hard surfaced road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 50* W. and S. 50* E.

45.40 Spur, slopes S. 70* W., desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.

52.30 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 270 ft. over SW. slope.

66.59 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 20 S., R. 9 W.

True point for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 40* E., 32 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R9W S3 CC BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 46* W., 56 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R9W S4 CC BT.

From this point the original closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, bears N. 0* 03' E., 0.375 chs. dist., monumented with a fir post, 4 ins. square, extending 3 ft. above ground, firmly set, witnessed as described in the official record of the 1953 resurvey.

From this same point, the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, T. 20 S., R. 9 W., bears S. 89* 28' W., 13.48 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, and yew; undergrowth, salmonberry, vine maple, thimbleberry, huckleberry, arrowwood, hazel, blackberry, Oregon grape, salal, and fern.
