Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 26 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS	
6.00	Top of rock bluff, 100 ft. high, edge bears N. 80* W. and S. 80* E.; desc. 200 ft. over steep rocky SW. slope and bluff.
16.00	Bottom of rocky descent, slopes S.; asc. 70 ft. over gradual SE. slope of benchland.
35.10	Gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 30* W., to W. and S. 30* E. on curve.
40.26	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. 41.50	Same gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 30* E., to E. and S. 30* W.
55.00	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 50 ft. over SW slope.
60.80	Creek, 8 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 200 ft. over SE. slope.
75.25	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 60 ft. over W. slope.
77.85	Gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 60* E. and W., to NW. on curve.
80.52	The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14.  Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, madrone, chinquapin, alder, maple, and pine; undergrowth, young timber, fern, salal, poison oak, vine maple, hazel, Oregon grape, manzanita, ceanothus, rhododendron, and mountain willow.
	N. 1* 17' E., bet. secs. 11 and 12.  Ascend 280 ft. along W. slope, changing to S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, along W. edge of logged area.
1.75	Gravelled road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 35* W., to N. and S. 55* E. on curve.
5.00	Same road, bears N. 30* W., to SW. and S. 10* W. on curve.
21.00	Spur ridge, bears N. 50* E. and S. 50* W.; desc. 510 ft. over steep rocky NW. slope.
36.50	Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
