 14.40 Leave open rocky barren, edge bears E. and W.
 17.60 Spur ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 35 ft. over NW. slope.
 23.00 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 60 ft. over SW. slope.
 26.00 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
 26.25 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 145 ft. over SW. slope.
 31.10 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
 35.85 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 130 ft. over NW. slope.
 39.93 Point for the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of original corner.
