7.00	Spur, slopes S.; desc. 165 ft. over W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
14.60	Leave timber; enter logged area, edge bears N. and S.
19.33	The SE 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 21.
	Descend 220 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.
33.50	Ravine, drains SW.; desc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.
