Dependent Resurvey, Portion of N. Bdy., T. 23 S., R. 1 W.

## CHAINS

- 14.65 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 35 ft. over NE. slope.
- 17.50 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft. over NW. slope.
- 19.19 Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34.  
Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 35° W., 74 lks. dist.  
mkd. W1/16 S 34 BT.
- A hemlock, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 52½° E., 37 lks. dist.  
mkd. W1/16 S3 BT.
- Descend 40 ft. over NW. slope.
- 21.50 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.
- 24.10 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
- 25.90 Buck Creek, 8 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 455 Ft. over SE. slope.
- 38.38 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked and witnessed as described in the record of the 1960 dependent resurvey.
- Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, yew, dogwood, madrone, pine, and oak; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, rhododendron, huckleberry, salal, wild rose, Oregon grape, poison oak, blackberry, sword and bracken fern.
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- S. 89° 26' W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.
- Ascend 315 ft. over SE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
- 2.75 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 55 ft. over SW. slope.
- 14.80 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 155 ft. over SE. slope
- 19.57 The E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked and witnessed as described in the record of the 1960 dependent resurvey.
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- S. 89° 15' W., beginning new measurement.
- Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope.
