

# County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

43.00

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, monumented with the original basalt stone, 12 x 10 x 8 ins., loosely set, 2 ins. in the ground, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the N. face, from which the original bearing trees:

A fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 65° W., 9 lks. dist., with scribe marks  $\frac{1}{4}$  S visible on opened blaze.

A root hole bears S. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 27 lks. dist., with a down fir alongside, 12 ins. diam., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 18° W., 51 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S30 BT.

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears S. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 48 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S31 BT.

Deposit the corner stone alongside the iron post.

Ascend 197 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. 10° W.; asc. 42 ft. over NE. slope.

Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.

Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 167 ft. over steep NW. slope.

Broken Leg Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 307 ft. over SE. slope,

Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 228 ft. over NW. slope.

Leave heavy timber, enter logged area, edges bear N. and W.
