

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of N. Bdy., T. 31 S., R. 5 W.

## CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings.  
Timber, fir, oak, madrone, pine, cedar, yew, chinquapin, and dogwood, undergrowth, salal, fern, poison oak, hazel, arrowwood, vine maple, Oregon grape, and reproduction.

S 89° 58' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Descend 15 ft. over NE. slope, across partially logged area, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

1.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N. 65° E.; asc. 400 ft. over SE. slope changing to E. slope.

17.30 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.

20.48 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 4 only.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E., 89 lks. dist.,  
mkd. E 1/16 S 4 BT.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 100 lks. dist.,  
mkd. E 1/16 S 4 BT.

Descend 22 ft. over NW. slope.

21.20 Ravine, drains N. 10° W.; asc. 185 ft. over NE. slope.

34.50 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 60° E. and S. 80° W.

37.20 Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.

40.30 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 33 only, on the S. bdy. of T. 30 S., R. 5 W., at proportionate distance, based on the 1854 Ford record. There is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.

Descend 20 ft. over NW. slope.

40.96 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 4 only, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
