Dependent Resurvey, Portion Subdivisional Lines, T. 31 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

A chinquapin, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 21° W., 202 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S18 BT.

Ascend 100 ft. over NE. slope.

44.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 365 ft. over broken NW. slope.

79.98 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree:

A fir, 58 ins. diam., bears N. 60° E., 40 lks. dist, with scribe marks S7 BT visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 25° E., 87 $\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. T31S R5W S18 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 164 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S13 BT.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears N. 7° W., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R6W S12 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings.

Timber, fir, oak, madrone, cedar, pine, hemlock, dogwood, yew, chinquapin, and alder; undergrowth, salal, fern, poison oak, Oregon grape, huckleberry, and reproduction.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18.

N. 2° 47' W., bet. secs. 7 and 8.

Ascend 150 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.80 Ridge, dividing Canyon Creek and Mitchell Creek drainage, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.; desc. 190 ft. over NW. slope changing to W. slope.

20.50 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 8.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
